



BEHOLD THE LAMB
40-DAY FAST

DEVOTIONAL GUIDE

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DAY 1 – THE CROSSING

For all of us, there is a journey along a narrow path that leads from the land of brokenness into the land of promise and wholeness in Christ. In Joshua chapter 3, we read how the Lord led the Israelites to crossover into their Promised Land. It is a prophetic history that speaks to God’s way of deliverance from severe oppression and enslavement to sin into inheriting the full promises of God for our freedom and redemption. It was only by Almighty God’s Presence that this crossover could take place.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: JOSHUA 3:1-17

In the story, we read how God instructed the Levites (the priests of the Lord) to carry the ark of the covenant (the Holy Presence and Word of God) to lead the way by being the first to set foot in the river. As they did, the power of God confirmed their obedience and parted the waters. The Levites walked through the Jordan River toward the Promised Land on dry ground. As instructed, they stood in the middle of the river carrying the Presence of God until the entire nation crossed over. The Levites were the first to step in and the last to step out.

The Levites represent intercessors filled with the Holy Spirit and obedient to God’s Word to stand in the gap until the promises of God are fulfilled. By faith, we stand believing God’s Word and His promises, and we pray for their fulfillment. *“Behold, the ark of the covenant of the Lord...”* (Joshua 3:11). As we behold the Lord, we follow Him. The Lord is the One leading us, and He goes before us. God leads us not in our own strength or ways, but into utter dependence upon Him. We must have a miracle from God to break open the pathway where there is no way. It is undeniable that salvation and deliverance can only come from God.

As we begin this fast, God is inviting us to unite in prayer with the Word of God and to step into the river. The river Jordan means, “descent unto death.” Therefore, we behold the Lamb of God who goes before us, and we heed His command to deny ourselves, pick up our cross, and follow Him (Luke 9:23).

PRAYER:

God, we honor You and Your plans of redemption. Flood our eyes with light to see what You are calling us to in this moment of history. May we be acutely sensitive to behold You, Jesus, to become like You, and to follow You wherever You are leading. Come, Holy Spirit, and fill us to overflowing with the supernatural strength of Your grace to stand in the ministry of intercession with You.

Almighty God, would You confirm our obedience with the parting of waters? May the path be seen and discerned through the eyes of faith. Break open the way and reveal Jesus. Reveal Your narrow path of life through Your Son that brings us out of bondage into freedom and out of sin’s slavery into the righteousness of Christ.

As we step into the river, we posture our heart and mind toward our goal in Christ: for the revealing of the Son of God to the LGBTQ+, that they will join us to, “Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world” (John 1:29).



DAY 2 – CONSECRATE YOURSELVES

Before the Israelites could cross over into the Promised Land, they received instruction from Joshua, “Consecrate yourselves, therefore, for tomorrow the LORD will do wonders among you” (Joshua 3:5). May we heed this word for ourselves as we set our hearts to fast and pray.

To consecrate means to sanctify and set apart as holy unto the Lord for His service and good pleasure. To sanctify ourselves before the Lord requires an inner examination of our heart and attitude toward purity, righteousness, and wholehearted devotion to God.

“If anyone cleanses himself from what is dishonorable, he will be a vessel for honorable use, set apart as holy, useful to the Master of the house, ready for every good work” (2 Timothy 2:21).

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: 2 Corinthians 6:16-7:1; Hebrews 10:22; 1 John 3:3

Just as Jesus opened Himself on the Cross, we encourage you to intentionally open yourself up to the Lord. For our prayers to be highly effective, we must embrace repentance and intentionally divorce ourselves from every known evil desire or compromise that wages war within us (1 Peter 2:11). Invite the Holy Spirit to search your mind and heart for anything unrighteous, idolatrous, or unclean.

PRAYER:

Come, Holy Spirit, with Your kindness that leads us into repentance. Release Your revelation light as we present ourselves before You. Holy Spirit, search us for any unconfessed sin or attitudes of our heart that are not in love or righteousness. As You do, we repent. We forgive. We release to You all that is unclean within us and receive the Blood of Jesus to wash us clean. Forgive us, Lord, and cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9). Purify our hearts and purify our intercession. Make us holy as You are holy (1 Peter 1:15-16).



DAY 3 – GOD’S HEART REVEALED

May our faith be stirred toward our covenant-keeping God. Hear Him say, *“Gather to Me my consecrated ones who have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice...Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me”* (Psalm 50:5, 15). Let us choose to believe in the goodness of God, who is entirely faithful to keep His promises.

Many believers have lost hope that they and the Church no longer have a place of influence to stop the immoral high tide related to LGBTQ+ issues. It is true that we live in a time when the culture around us is getting darker and darker. Now, more than ever, do we need to fast and pray for God to break in to do the impossible with great power and love. There is no time for fear and doubt; we must step into faith and let our intercession transcend what is seen around us and prevail in the courts of heaven, where our prayers are heard by the God who answers and acts on our behalf.

For over thirty years now, Lou Engle has carried a prophetic word and vision seen by Bob Jones related to the LGBTQ+ community. Bob Jones prophesied there would be a wave of 100,000 homosexuals who come to Christ, and that the 100,000 would be just the first wave of many to come. He also prophesied that this spiritual conversion wave would cause salvations to come about suddenly.

The Lord’s heart is for none to perish but for all to be reconciled back into intimate relationship with Him. Let’s unite in our asking for 100,000 who identify as LGBTQ+ to be radically transformed and saved, leaving behind their LGBTQ+ identity to follow Christ. Let’s contend before the Lord for Saul-like conversions to Jesus so powerful that these 100,000 would become preachers of righteousness in their own communities, bringing about a ripple effect of radical salvations and healings.

PRAYER:

Almighty God, just like Saul (who hated and persecuted Christians) encountered Jesus and his life was forever changed for the glory of God, by faith we dare to believe that some of the greatest Christians the world has yet to see will come out of the LGBTQ+ community. Nothing is impossible for You. May some of the most politically active LGBTQ+ transfer into God’s Kingdom with holy zeal to love Him with all their heart, soul, mind, and strength. And like the transformation from Saul to Paul, may they become God’s special messengers filled with the Holy Spirit, now using their voices to call for radical obedience to Jesus. We pray for their lives to be a sign and wonder of God’s power that produces the fruit of repentance—leaving their sins behind and evidencing real change and freedom. We call forth complete transformations of the heart that are now set ablaze by God’s holy fire. And, like John the Baptist, may they release a cry that will shake their communities and even the nations, causing a great turning back to God.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION and PRAYER: Isaiah 61:1-7



DAY 4 – THE WAILING WALL

As intercessors, we not only carry the prophetic word of the Lord, we prepare the way for its fulfillment. We catch wind of the dreams and visions of God, and in the place of prayer we partner with God's desire to see His intentions come to pass. Our words of intercession begin to clear the pathway of all obstacles and hindrances so that at the appointed time, His Word will run swiftly to its desired destination and fulfillment.

Many times, Lou Engle has encouraged people to pray into the dreams the Lord gives. Lou's friend received a powerful dream from the Lord. This friend saw a wall like the Wailing Wall in Jerusalem where the Jews gather to pray and insert written prayers of petition into the wall's crevices. In the dream, there were little pieces of paper in the wall inscribed with the names of individuals who were struggling with same-sex desires, and others with LGBTQ+ brokenness. People came and laid their hands on these names, weeping over them. As they did this, suddenly the names would disappear from the wall and fly over to a testimony board where there was a record of people whose lives had been changed and transformed by the power of God. On this testimony board (likened to a wall) flew a banner that read "100,000 LGBTQ saved and transformed."

The Lord then spoke to Lou saying, "I am going to raise up a wailing wall of intercession. There is coming a wave of thousands that are going to be touched by the love and power of God. It will be the first wave of what will become a *Jesus movement*."

Years ago, Lou's pastor also had a dream. In his pastor's dream, he went to the Church, but the Church would not receive him. When he went to the homosexual community, however, they did receive him. The pastor woke from the dream and felt the Lord speak to him, "What the hippies were to the Jesus movement of the 60s and 70s, the rainbow people will be for the Jesus movement that is now coming upon us. Thousands will be saved. Everywhere, people will be saved."

PRAYER:

It is time for us to raise up this wailing wall of intercession for those who are bound in same-sex desire, distorted gender identity, and sexual confusion of all kinds that perverts the image and nature of God. Begin to ask God to highlight the names of people you know who have been gripped by sin's oppression and deception in their identities. As a prophetic act symbolizing their deliverance, see yourself inserting these names into the wailing wall and allow Jesus' heart to move you into love's travail.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: John 15:1, 4, 7-8



DAY 5 – THE HUMBLE HEART

We are asking for God to immerse us in the humility of Jesus—causing a mighty transformation within us, so that through humility, the power of God would dethrone pride and restore humanity to its original created design, made in the image of God (Genesis 1:27).

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Proverbs 16:18; Isaiah 2:11; 1 Samuel 17:1-58

We can do more in humility than we ever could in pride. It is for this reason we are praying for a baptism of humility to come upon us as intercessors and upon the Lord's Church. As we stand in our baptism, fully dependent on God, may the power of humility destroy the works of evil and the power of pride.

PRAYER:

God, we pray that You would open our eyes to see with clarity and to recognize how pervasive humility is within the nature of God, the fellowship of the Trinity, and the atmosphere of Kingdom life in heaven. Increase our depth of intimacy in the knowledge of You and the humility of Jesus. May we begin to experience the joy and fellowship of humility on earth as it is in heaven.

God, we acknowledge You and say thank you for Your abiding Presence within us. Lord, what a humble act this is, that You have chosen to give and share Yourself so freely. Thank you. Jesus, You are Humility. We give Humility permission to have its way in us. Lord, cast out every shadow of pride within us. Leave no stone unturned. Jesus, we want more of You. Lord, enlighten our hearts with Your beautiful intentions for us to be like You in holiness and humility. In light and truth, do Your sanctifying work within us. We desire You, the Humble King, to be comfortably at home within us.

In humility, we present before You this LGBTQ+ movement of PRIDE. God, we recognize that here before us is a blatant clashing of kingdoms: the kingdom of darkness against Your Kingdom of light. The spirit of this age is raging against Your Kingdom and mocking Your righteous guidelines for holy living (Psalm 2:1-3). God, we are asking for Your divine intervention. Only the power of Christ's humility can slay this giant named PRIDE in our land.



DAY 6 – PEOPLE OF HIS PRESENCE

God is after our hearts through relationship with His glorious Presence. This is our redemption—being in intimate relationship with God who is holy and full of glory. In furtherance of our consecration to God, let us respond to the Lord’s wisdom to seek His face, focus on His glory, and become people of His Presence. As we do, may it prepare the way for those in darkness to see His glory arise upon them (Isaiah 60:1-2).

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: John 17:21-24; Psalm 27:4, 8, 13-14; 2 Corinthians 3:16-18

The union of abiding sonship is the intimacy God desires with us, because it is the intimacy of the Trinity. In His *being* and being one with Him as He is One, our needs are refined and sanctified by His glory. The light of His countenance will reveal our deepest and truest need beyond all others—His Presence.

As we pray for those who struggle with same-sex attraction, gender dysphoria, or identify themselves as LGBTQ+, our goal is not behavioral change, nor is it to be relieved of pain; our goal is union with the glorious Presence of God. Yes, we need His *doing*, but our higher need is for His *being*. His *being*, His Presence, His glory is the pursuit esteemed by God with a promise that He will meet us there (James 4:8). As we behold the glory of the Lord—consumed with the Person and Presence of God, gazing upon His infinite beauty and in awe of His manifold perfections—His glory will manifest in our hearts and through our prayers. As we stay in this holy alignment, our prayers will prepare the way for those who are being set free to be centered on His glorious Presence as well.

PRAYER:

God, we love You and long for more of You. Thank you for being with us and for filling us with Your Holy Presence. We desire abiding communion and oneness with You, Jesus. You know our longing isn’t just for ourselves, but for the lost and broken as well. Therefore, would You release divine encounters with Jesus and invitations to know You as you really are. Transform us all into people of Your Presence.

Jesus, we proclaim Your truth: You are the desire of every desire. You are the fulfillment to every longing. You are the answer to every attraction. You are the solution to every perversion. It is not what You do, it is who You are. Draw us in to more of You—our beautiful King. You are the radiance of God, manifested for our eyes to see and our hearts to know. You are so beautiful, King Jesus. Let Your glory be revealed. Let Your beauty be unveiled and put on display for everyone to see and know You. You are the beautiful One; You are the Holy One. “Let the whole earth be filled with the knowledge and beauty of the glory of the LORD as the waters cover the sea” (Habakkuk 2:14).



DAY 7 – THE VOICE CRYING OUT

The title of this fast is *Behold the Lamb*. This public proclamation was made by John the Baptist when he saw Jesus coming to him to be baptized. The location of this proclamation was at the crossing on the banks of the Jordan River leading into the Promised Land (John 1:28; Joshua 3). Here is also where the baptismal ministry of John the Baptist took place and where he baptized Jesus before He stepped into public ministry.

John said of himself, *“I am fulfilling Isaiah’s prophecy: ‘I am an urgent, thundering voice shouting in the desert—clear the way and prepare your hearts for the coming of the Lord Yahweh!’”* (John 1:23, TPT). John’s message was clear: *“The realm of heaven’s kingdom is about to appear—so you’d better keep turning away from evil and turn back to God!”* (Matthew 3:2, TPT). It was an urgent call to those around him to leave sin behind and turn their life around by coming back to the holy God.

Today, let us pray back to God the Word of the Lord spoken through Isaiah and John the Baptist. May God anoint our intercessory cry to be the preparation, so that every dry and weary soul is ready to behold and receive the Lamb of God. We are asking God to cleanse hearts so that they might be primed to receive Jesus Christ. May our work of intercessory preparation make a way for God’s Word to be fulfilled, *“And the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together”* (Isaiah 40:5).

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION and PRAYER: John 1:23; Isaiah 40:3-5; Luke 1:16-17, 76-79; Luke 3:3-6



DAY 8 – BEHOLD THE LAMB: BAPTISM

Jesus was revealed to John the Baptist as the perfect and spotless Lamb of God who was willing to sacrifice Himself for our sins. John’s proclamation—*behold the Lamb*—was a declaration of the Father’s provision to fully reconcile us back to God. Along with this declaration, at least four important occurrences happened at the crossing location: the story of the Israelites crossing the Jordan River into their Promised Land; John’s ministry of baptism in the Jordan; Jesus being baptized in the same waters; and the prophetic promise John speaks of Jesus’ ministry about the baptism of the Holy Spirit. As mentioned before, Jordan means “descent unto death,” because the river descends into the Dead Sea. Baptism itself is a crossing from death to life. As we are baptized, we are sealed with the promise of full redemption made possible by the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Through Jesus, our inherited promise is full communion and union with God by the Blood of the Lamb and the power of the Holy Spirit.

Where sin separated us from God, baptism is the means by which God separates sin from us. The judgment of death becomes the judgment of life. Baptism speaks to the death of evil and the removal of sin, to the resurrection from the dead and the receiving of eternal life, and to our flesh being liberated and redeemed with the infilling of the Holy Spirit. Baptism is a transformational event full of power. It is beyond a symbolic act; it is the rebirth as a new creation, enabling us to walk in the newness of life (1 Peter 3:18-22; Romans 6:4).

Let us intercede for the complete, transformational work of baptism to take place in the LGBTQ+ community: from death to self unto resurrection life in Christ, and from death to sin to being made alive to God. Again, let us pray the Word of God.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION and PRAYER: Luke 3:16-17; John 1:29-34; Romans 5:15-6:14



DAY 9 – JESUS FASTED 40 DAYS

After Jesus was baptized by John, the Holy Spirit drove Jesus into the wilderness to be tested and tempted by the devil. Jesus' redemptive suffering in the wilderness restored the Israelites' 40 years of wilderness tribulation. It also revealed Jesus' strength against the accuser and having completed the 40 days of trial and testing, Jesus overcame the seduction and power of temptation without sin. Through Jesus' time in the wilderness, He interceded for the complete redemption of humankind and stood in the gap for God's plans and promises to be fulfilled. Because Jesus withstood the devil's harassment and came out blameless, Jesus emerged from the wilderness armed with the Holy Spirit's power.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: [Matthew 3:11-4:11](#)

Let's beseech God to have His way in and through our 40 day fast.

PRAYER:

Father God, just as Jesus gained redemptive ground through fasting, we continue to dedicate this fast to You for Your glory. May Your saving power go forth beyond anything we can imagine. May the devil's strongholds and power break because we have embraced the humility of fasting by the Blood of the Lamb and the grace of Your Spirit. Have Your will and way alone, God.

We ask for a special grace to fast and for Your anointing that breaks the yoke to rest on our prayers (Isaiah 10:27). As a result, we ask for Your power to go forth, that Your Word would run swiftly into people's hearts, and that Your name would be glorified. We follow You, Jesus, and Your Kingdom's way to bring about mass restoration and breakthrough. God, just as You did with Jesus, would You validate our ministry of intercession as You see fit with signs, astonishing wonders, powerful miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit (Hebrews 2:4). We ask for many to be saved and rescued, in Jesus' name.



DAY 10 – BEHOLD THE WORD OF GOD

The Word of God is powerful. When Jesus was in the wilderness, He overcame temptation by believing and speaking the Word of God. Scripture also tells us that Jesus *is* the Word. Therefore, we are praying for Jesus, the Word of God, to be the means of overcoming temptation toward sexual immorality.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: John 1:1-5, 8:12; 1 Corinthians 10:12-14; Joshua 1:7-9; Psalm 119:105-107

PRAYER:

Almighty God, may Your Word go forth in power. We are asking for the Word of God to push back the encroaching darkness. Shine forth the light of Your Word that causes darkness to flee. May Jesus be seen as the way of escape promised in times of temptation. You are truly the way, the Word, and the light. Jesus, may You be seen, known, and received as the true path into everlasting joy, life, and pleasures forevermore.



DAY 11 – UNDERGROUND RAILROAD: THE WAY OF ESCAPE

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Ephesians 2:1-10; 1 Corinthians 10:13-14

A few years ago, an intercessor praying for those with unwanted same-sex attraction, gender confusion, and the LGBTQ+ community at large, received a vision in which the Lord showed her a tunnel and He instructed her, “*Pray the way out of temptation.*” He showed her that the tunnel was His provision as a way of escape, like the Underground Railroad through which runaway slaves found an escape to freedom. This tunnel became a visual representation of the Lord’s promise to always provide a way out of temptation, which is a means of fleeing sexual immorality.

As the Lord likened it to the Underground Railroad, He also highlighted Harriet Tubman’s role as a forerunner, deliverer, and abolitionist. In the Spirit, our intercession has a likened role. God showed us the importance of intercession that prepares the way out of sin’s slavery and into the Lord’s Promised Land of freedom and blessing. The Lord continued to reveal that this tunnel’s name is Grace, for it is “*by grace you have been saved*” (Ephesians 2:4). He has provided grace to overcome temptation, and the strength of grace to endure transformation.

The Lord has promised that His grace is effective and sufficient against any danger and also His provision for endurance. This way of escape is God’s way of deliverance out of slavery and into fellowship with Jesus Christ. As we cover people in prayer regarding these issues, the Lord is sounding an alarm for us to pray the way out of temptation. Satan is the tempter, and he preys on human desires by means of temptation (Matthew 4:3). We are guaranteed temptation and testing in this life, but temptation can sometimes be particularly difficult at the onset of change—when sin is starved out and new life choices begin.

Let us rejoice that God, who is rich in mercy and faithfully compassionate in nature, has planned and prepared ways of escape. Those who choose to walk down the Lord’s path are given a promise, “*Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him*” (James 1:12). Let us help those who are enslaved to LGBTQ+ sin receive this promise by praying the way out of temptation. As we do, we will give them the fighting chance to be the overcomers they are called to be.

PRAYER:

Lord, we humbly come before You and ask You to use our prayers to bring forth the fulfillment of Your will. As You anointed and sent out Moses and Harriet Tubman to be Your deliverers, would You anoint our intercession for salvation and deliverance? May our prayers go forth with power leading the way for breakthrough. Thank you for Your wisdom and heavenly strategy to pray the way out of temptation. We thank you for responding by making a way through the tunnel of grace.

God, You have commissioned us to pray through this tunnel of transition, to help set the captives free and light the way out. By Your Spirit, Almighty God, let the sound of our prayers be heard like a trumpet of freedom that awakens enslaved souls to Your pathway of everlasting life. As newly found freedom and the blessing of life begin to have their way, we ask for the Lord’s joy to be established in those liberated. Thank you for all that You are doing and all that You are going to do. Thank you for victory and triumph over the enemy!



DAY 12 – CONTINUING IN GRACE

Through the release of our prayers, the effects of darkness are being pushed back, opportunities to see and choose the Lord are being given, and scrolls of life and true identity are being released from heaven to those who have struggled with same-sex attraction, gender insecurity, and sexual sin. Keep pressing into His Word and contend for His promises. New life is available. As we continue to collectively stand in the place of intercession, declaring and decreeing the heart and will of the Lord, the establishment of God's Kingdom coming to the earth is hastened.

Let us be reminded that God has shown us His tunnel of grace in order that we might pray through it—to prepare the way out of temptation and ease the transition of deliverance. As His intercessors, the Lord is sending us in through this tunnel and up to the enemy's gates to help set the captives free and lead them out. We are asking the Lord to use our prayers to light the way of escape so that many will see Him as Savior and respond to the gospel of Jesus Christ. The Lord's power greatly exceeds the driving forces of sin. His arm is not too short to save.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Isaiah 43:16-21; James 1:12; Galatians 5:1

PRAYER:

Thank you, Jesus, for Your sacrifice and how You ransomed us back to the Father. You are the great Savior and Mediator; thank you for Your ministry of reconciliation. Lord, we unite together as Your Body and come before You to stand in the gap to intercede for every heart burdened with same-sex attraction and wrestling with their God-given sexual identity and gender. We ask for their salvation, healing, and complete reconciliation. May they receive the new life You died to give them. Draw them into true love and relationship with You.

By faith, let our worship and intercession begin to fill this tunnel. As we do, God, would You manifest Your glorious Presence in this tunnel of transition? May the atmosphere of worship and intercession that is in our hearts and around Your throne fill the way of escape with Your love, light, and glory. Let Your Kingdom come; pour out Your Spirit, God. Would You fill this tunnel with Your Presence and send forth Your ministering angels to assist in their escape? Come, Holy Spirit, come.



DAY 13 – BEHOLD THE GREAT HIGH PRIEST

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Hebrews 4:14-16; 5:7-10; 7:24-25; Matthew 8:17; Isaiah 53:4

We find ourselves living in a time where sexuality and sexual desire have no borders. As moral and sexual lawlessness have abounded all the more in the culture around us, the temptation toward sexual sin has greatly increased and has been set on an ever-increasing trajectory. Temptation exposes weakness and tests our devotion to God. However, we can find much comfort from the writer of Hebrews, who highlights Jesus as the perfect helper when temptation comes: *“For because He Himself has suffered when tempted, He is able to help those who are being tempted”* (Hebrews 2:18).

To be tempted is to be human, and Jesus fully shared in our humanity. He was tempted in every way just as we are, yet He was without sin. Let us take great consolation in this, because triumphing over temptation qualified Jesus as the Great High Priest who was able to *save us to the uttermost*. He was ultimately subjected to temptation’s suffering. More than that, He triumphed and was made perfect by it that we might be saved and conquer temptation by being holy as He is holy through the abiding Holy Spirit.

PRAYER:

Jesus, You grew in grace—may we grow in grace as well (Luke 2:52). You learned obedience through suffering—teach us this obedience. You were perfected through suffering—perfect us in steadfast love.

We will not hold back our cries and tears as we pray to the One who is able to save. Jesus, we magnify Your name and we proclaim that You will forever be our faithful High Priest. Jesus, we thank you that Your intercession has never stopped! You have continued to cry out to the Father to help us in temptation and save us from the death that sin brings. Let our prayers be Your prayers that are mighty to save.

Lord, the sexual temptations in this age are great, and we are in dire need of Your help! From every which way, we are tempted to give up sexual purity and to embrace sin’s pleasures. Therefore, we ask for a great saving from the onslaught of sexual lust and temptation. We repent for believing it is our human right to engage in sexual immortality. We renounce the lie that sexual sin liberates the true self. By the power of the Blood of Jesus, demagnetize every lie and cut every soul free from its deception; break the power of Satan’s seduction.

Holy Spirit, come and fill; renew the mind and purify desire. Where there has been deception clouding the mind and heart, release the healing power of Your truth that sets free. Restore true love, identity, and belonging with abiding sonship. Rebuild the devastation with the strength of well-being and the beauty of Your new creation giving You glory.



DAY 14 – BEHOLD THE SAVIOR

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Galatians 1:3-5; Acts 4:12

Jesus Christ alone is our Savior. As we come into a more intimate knowing of Him as Savior, our prayers become infused with miraculous faith to see His saving hand deliver us from sickness, sin, destruction, and hell.

The Good News is all about Jesus and believing in Him. Jesus is the perfect atoning sacrifice that saves us from hell, preserves us as children of God in the Kingdom of God, and delivers us from all that is evil around and *within* us. Jesus destroyed the works of the devil by His work on the Cross and took back the ultimate power over sin and death through His death, resurrection, and ascension into heaven. He is now seated at the right hand of God our Father—having been given the highest place of honor, with the name above every name, ever-living to make intercession for us. What joy it is to believe, and what a blessed assurance salvation brings to those who receive Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior!

Salvation is far more than the initial decision to believe in Jesus Christ and be saved from the consequences of sin in eternal damnation (although this forgiveness is salvation's ultimate gift!). Jesus Christ our Savior saves, delivers, rescues, preserves, and protects those who put their faith in Him. Salvation through relationship with Jesus has the power to bring dynamic transformation into our lives *now*, not just in the glorification to come. His salvation brings healing in the place of suffering and works wholeness for the broken. Salvation is designed to be a reality of increasing righteousness in our everyday lives that leads to sanctification.

PRAYER:

Almighty God, we specifically ask for You to come as Savior and rescue Your children who have been struggling with sexual purity, same-sex attraction, and gender identity confusion. God, the temptations to assuage the desires of our flesh assault us on every side. These temptations are multifaceted, especially for those who have homosexual and transgender inclinations. Jesus, we cry out to You, our Savior! Come and save!

Mighty Savior, will You come and fill the empty and deprived places within the soul that are vulnerable to temptation and sin? Cover every weak place that is exposed to this suffering. Satisfy the deepest of needs. Reveal Yourself as Savior. Transform us by healing our mind, heart, and body. Impart Your strength and grace for us to stand in purity. Work together for good within those who are in agony over their sinful affections and cause a fruitful crop to be produced from their holy suffering. Well up from within them the delight that You feel over them. You who began a good work of salvation and redemption in them, carry in on to completion. You are the finisher.



DAY 15 – HEALING THE SEARED CONSCIENCE

We are asking God to remove the deadening effects of a seared conscience and praying for new life to revive and restore back to a good and healthy conscience. We are seeking God to awaken our hearts to clearly see the distinctions between what is pure and what is defiled.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Psalm 119:7, 9; Psalm 139:14; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; Titus 1:15; Hebrews 9:14; Ezekiel 36:25-27

God has given every person the gift of conscience—the innate instinct to know right from wrong, which is commonly described as an inner moral compass. A healthy conscience will feel peace when one chooses rightly and guilt when a wrong choice is made. When a bad choice is considered, a good conscience will send off a signal or a “check” inside to reconsider making this choice. It will also incite us to consistently make good choices to maintain peace in our soul.

Satan is a master at deceiving the conscience to sin. We know from James 1:15, that *“Once desire has been conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin fully grown, eventually breeds death.”* One of the first places we experience this death is in our conscience. Desire will always have its debate there, but if the debate is lost and sin is chosen, our conscience will give off signals of remorse. When we consistently ignore these God-given signals of guilt because of wrongdoing, we begin to wound and mute our own conscience. Searing the conscience is Satan’s necessary tool that enables a person to accept their sin as normal and even needed.

Repentance is the only cure to restore the ignored and wounded conscience. Because the conscience is our inner moral compass, repentance is the only way to recalibrate to “true north” and be dialed-in to Truth (Jesus).

PRAYER:

Let us draw near with a “true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water” (Hebrews 10:22).

Heavenly Father, we thank you for the incredible gift of conscience that you deposited into each of us. Thank you for this gift that draws us toward Your righteous law and the truth (Romans 2:13-15). Your design is beautiful, Lord, and full of intricate wisdom. It is for love that You created us with the instincts to know right from wrong. Like a protective guard or a watchman on the wall of our soul, our conscience can warn us and keep us from harm. Thank you, Lord. Teach us to appreciate and steward this gift with the utmost care.

Thank you for giving us such great capacity with the ability to learn wisdom. We acknowledge that You have given us a powerful gift through this gift of conscience—the power to assess decisions and make choices, whether for good or evil. This is no small thing, and we say thank you. Come, Holy Spirit; would You breathe new life into our conscience and teach us Your ways? Cause us to learn righteousness and know its wisdom. Guard us according to Your Word and help us to keep our hearts pure and upright before You and others. Restore the gift of conscience with the oil of gladness and the fullness of joy as we unite with Your heart. Purify our conscience to wholeheartedly serve You.



DAY 16 – LIES OF SHAME

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Romans 5:2, 5; Proverbs 13:5; Hebrews 12:1-2

For the purposes of this prayer, it is important to know that shame is not godly conviction or holy sorrow for wrongdoing. Shame comes into agreement with the accuser and attacks our identity with false beliefs about ourselves and God's love for us.

PRAYER:

God, thank you that You do not put us to shame. You despise shame, because it is shame that says, "I am hopelessly flawed and different from everybody else. I am a mistake. I am the wrong gender. I am what I say I am because my experience and my feelings tell me so." We declare that shame is a liar!

Father God, we come before You to break all agreement with shame. We are asking You to remove every tentacle of shame within, no matter how deep and twisted it runs. Thank you for Your love that approaches shame in order to bring freedom from its tormenting curse. Break-in with Your passionate love! Draw many into Your heart that they might have restored identities rooted in Christ.

We repent for believing the lies of shame. Reveal every lie so that these can be broken and renounced by name. We renounce the lie that the way to get over shame is to agree with it and to accept it as our identity. God, break this deception off this generation! With the power of the Blood of Jesus, we break the partnership shame has had with self-hatred, which at its root is a partnership with pride. On behalf of ourselves and those who we are praying for, by the Blood of the Lamb we renounce every word curse, every false "I am" statement, and break all agreement with the lies and accusations that have been spoken. (Ask God to bring to mind any specific "I am" shame statements or word curses that need to be renounced and do so now.)

Lord, in place of all the false "I am" statements, release the divine revelation of the Great I AM (Exodus 3:13-14). We declare to every soul: He is God, and He is eternal. God is secure. God is stable. He does not change (Malachi 3:6). It is God, I AM THAT I AM, who has created you, who has planned you, who has predestined you. It is the Great I AM who delivers you and calls you home unto everlasting life. Beloved, He desires for you to know truth in your inner being—for you to know who you really are and Whose you are. He desires to deliver you from the lies of the accuser, replacing them with stability, security, and peace. You are His, beloved.

We declare and decree: In Christ, you are loved. You are chosen. You are not a mistake. There is no flaw created in you (Song of Solomon 4:7). You are beautifully and wonderfully made by Your Creator (Psalm 139). You are accepted. You belong. You are adopted (Ephesians 1:5). You are worth His sacrifice. Jesus has fought for you and continues to fight for you. We proclaim victory and freedom over your identity in Christ and complete deliverance from the whole systematic structure of shame.



DAY 17 – RADIANT JOY

Yesterday, we prayed for freedom from all shame. In continuance, we want to pray for God’s radiant joy to come in like a flood where shame once resided.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Psalm 34:5; Isaiah 61:1-7; Psalm 16:11

PRAYER:

We prophetically declare that instead of shame they shall receive a double portion of restoration with everlasting joy. Hallelujah, let it be so! Let those who look to You be radiant with joy, Lord! Thank you that shame is not their inheritance, but everlasting joy.

Joy of the Lord, come! Begin to spring up from the inside. May Your great joy—that is pure happiness and delight at being in relationship with them and Your enjoyment of who they are in Christ—fill them with a satisfaction that can never run dry (John 17:13). Cause them to experience true abiding satisfaction that can only come from You.

We declare over them, “The Lord your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness; He will quiet you by His love; He will exult over you with loud singing” (Zephaniah 3:17).

Sing, God, sing! Release Your sound over them with songs of deliverance, songs of hope, and songs of joy. May Your voice resound to the very core of their being with blessing and life. Let Your song become their song of rejoicing and praise. We exalt You, God. You alone are worthy of worship!



DAY 18 – BEHOLD THE HEALER

We continue to unite ourselves with Christ, His Cross, and His Blood as we ask Him to intervene on behalf of the sexually broken. We specifically lift up those who are in agony over their own affections and who have been desiring change for a long time.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: John 5:2-9

PRAYER:

Lord, we not only ask for the strength, grace, and endurance for them to stand in the midst of temptation, but we ask for the inner healing of the soul that removes the vulnerability and attraction toward sin. God, would You bring healing's relief to their suffering? Would You restore hope and faith with a newfound confidence in You as Healer?

Your Word is full of power. God, when You speak, Your words are active, operative, energizing, and effective. You can divide soul from spirit, reaching even the deepest parts of our nature to expose, sift, analyze, and judge the very thoughts and purposes of our heart. By Your Holy Spirit, would You speak out Your question once again to those wanting healing: "Do you want to be healed?" Cause Your Living Word to pierce their hearts with the clarity to say yes once again.

To those who say yes, make them whole and satisfy every desire for healing and transformational change. Cure every troubled or traumatized place of the mind, heart, and soul. We ask for Your Word to deeply cleanse and wash over them with great assurance and peace. Bring healing to the brokenhearted. If hope deferred has caused them to lay in a sickbed of fatalistic despair or self-pity, may they hear the healing words of Jesus, "Get up, take up your bed, and walk." Cause our intercession to release supernatural grace for them to rightly respond.

Jesus, reveal Yourself as Healer.



DAY 19 – FORSAKING IDOLATRY

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Mark 12:29-30; Matthew 4:10; 2 Corinthians 6:16-7:1

God has created us with a natural instinct and impulse to worship. God's original and redemptive intention has been for us to worship Him alone in a loving and interactive relationship with the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Even so, worship is not just a command from the Lord; it is a need in every human heart that has been woven into the fabric of our being. Our need to worship is only truly fulfilled and satisfied as we worship God. He is the only One worthy of worship and the only One who rightly responds. Our redemptive call is to worship God in Spirit and truth with adoration and thanksgiving to the One who is wholly Other: uncreated, set apart, sovereign, and glorious.

When God is not worshiped, something or someone takes His place as the object of our affection. As spiritual beings, we cannot flip a switch to cease our worship; we can only redirect it. If we are not worshipping God, we will be worshipping idols. An idolatrous bent is the human condition apart from God.

When evil pride (considering ourselves God or equal with Him) enters our hearts, idolatry has been conceived. This sin separates us from God, and this separation causes our heart to be divided. God's restoration of humankind is a restoration of the heart in the redemption of becoming wholeheartedly devoted in loving worship to God alone. As His redeemed, we will then be known by His love in our hearts; not the world's love or our own self-centered love, but the passionate love of God alive in and through us toward one another.

PRAYER:

Father God, we declare Your promise from Ezekiel 36:25-27 where You said, "I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleanness, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes and be careful to obey My rules."

In a spirit of repentance, we renounce and forsake all idolatry. God, we are contending through prayer for the restoration of true worshipers to arise out of the LGBTQ+ community. We declare over them Your living Word spoken by Jesus, "But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in Spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship Him. God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in Spirit and truth...I who speak to you am He" (John 4:23-24, 26). Yes, behold the Lamb, and become true worshipers of God.



DAY 20 – RESURRECTION HOPE

We are asking God to draw many who identify as LGBTQ+ into a vibrant relationship with Jesus. We are asking for many “to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead” (1 Peter 1:3).

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Ezekiel 37:1-14

PRAYER:

Jesus, You rose from the dead as Lord of life so that we might rise and impart Your real life to those most in need of it. “Faith is the assurance of things hoped for” (Hebrews 11:1). Therefore, we stand in the assurance of the things we are hoping for that line up with Your Word. We step into faith right now and release living hope—Your Word that is alive, active, and full of resurrection power. Let Your Kingdom come. Let Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Release Your power from on high to deliver those in LGBTQ+ darkness.

We join together in intercession to prophetically declare that according to His great mercy, God will cause you to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. Dry bones, hear the Word of the Lord! He has promised to put His own Spirit within you so that you will live! He has promised to make the valley of trouble into a door of hope (Hosea 2:15)! Hear the Word of the Lord: He will breathe new life into you, and you shall live! You are not destined for death. You are not destined for dryness. You are destined to carry His breath of life through the resurrection of His Son, who died to give you Life (Jesus).

God, come with Your resurrection power. For those in sexual bondage and identity confusion, open their graves and raise them to life! We declare resurrection life over every dry bone. We declare to these dear ones: Let Him redeem you and bring you back to life. You have not been cut off. You have not been abandoned by Him. You are not so far gone that hope is lost on you.

We give thanks to You, God, for You are good and Your steadfast love endures forever! Remember these dear ones and have mercy. Raise them to life so that they might reveal Your glory.



DAY 21 – MADE IN HIS IMAGE

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Genesis 1:26-27; Colossians 3:9-10; Romans 1:19-25

Despite today's confusion and chaos over gender identity, the spiritual reality remains: male/female gender identity goes beyond itself and is rooted in the image of God. Only our Creator can make and establish our *being*. As we abide in union with God, He takes us on the journey of discovering who we are created to be and reveals to us the mystery of *being*.

As the Lord's healing journey is embarked upon, His perfect love rids us of confusion and aligns us with proper relationship between the masculine and feminine; He reveals where we have over-identified with either and fills every place of deprivation. The abiding Presence of the Holy Spirit seeks to integrate and appropriate the holy in every area of our being. This integration is restoration. It is being born anew unto wholeness in Christ.

We are praying for the release of wisdom and the understanding that we have been divinely made in God's image. We are asking for the Lord to heal and restore those with insecure or confused gender identities, and for Him to pour out His Spirit to impart His holy masculinity and holy femininity into every person that is a new creation in Him. We are asking for redemption in the area of gender security and wholeness that reveals the glory of God.

PRAYER:

God, we come before You as the Lord our Maker. We come with hearts of worship and praise. We bow down and kneel before You, Creator God, the Maker of heaven and earth. You alone are God, and by Your hand all things were made. Marvelous is the work of Your hands! You are the Giver and Sustainer of life. Everything You created was good and with excellence. We bow in reverence, honor, and submission as created beings worshiping their Creator God. We thank you for all You have made.

God, would you open the eyes of our hearts and reveal to us the transcendent nature of gender—that which reveals You in holy masculinity and holy femininity—and how we bear Your image? Thank you for creating humans in Your likeness. Teach us to honor Your image in our spirit, soul, and body. Thank You for creating and blessing us as male and female. Thank you that our gender is rooted in You. May gender and gender's expression mentally, psychologically, behaviorally, and anatomically be grounded in You. May Your image be recognized in us and in those for whom we pray.

Would You awe us with who You are in the fullness of Your splendor? Would You reveal to us Your mysteries that are hidden yet made visible through our bodies? We thank you for how You enable us to see who You are through the holiness of gender. Thank you for Your beauty manifested in us. Lead us into greater revelation regarding Your transcendent meanings. As You reveal and restore more and more of Yourself in us and in those who have insecurities in their gender identity as male or female, may we be found praising, "I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Your works are wonderful, I know that full well" (Psalm 139:14).



DAY 22 – CREATED IN CHRIST

Let us continue to pray for the restoration of personhood and identity, created in Christ Jesus. Let us go deep in prayer using the Word of God.

PRAYER:

Holy Spirit, come with wisdom and revelation. Open the eyes of our heart to receive Your Living Word. Circumcise our ears to hear Your intercession. God, as we read Your Word, fill us with Your breath to pray. Increase our sensitivity to every intention of Your heart. Bind our hearts to Yours, Lord. May we see what You see and feel what You feel in the full intensity of Your love. Pour out Your Spirit and may all be filled with the fullness of God. With open hearts we open Your Word to pray.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION and PRAYER: Ephesians 1:16-19; 2:10; Psalm 139



DAY 23 – REDEEMING LOVE

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: 1 John 4:15-18; Ephesians 3:14-19

PRAYER:

God, we thank you for souls being saved in the LGBTQ+ community and for how Your redeeming love restores Your image within and without. Thank you that whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, You will come and make home with them. You do not withhold Yourself. So come, Lord, come and fill these dear ones with Your Spirit. Come and fill every person with Your abiding love. Thank you that You do not leave us as You find us, but as You abide in us, Your love and likeness are being perfected in us. Come with Your perfect love. Strengthen their inner being so that You may dwell in their hearts with the fullness of Your Presence.

We speak forth strength to every languishing spirit. Rise up! Rise up in strength! We breathe joy back into your life and joy back into your bones. We breathe forth the love of God. We say, we love you. You are worth fighting for; you are worth hoping for. Can you hear us? We want you, and we welcome you into the Kingdom. Come out of hiding! Come out of shame! Come forth and take your place in God's family. Receive the life God has set before you. He has plans and purposes for you. We unite with His delight to give you His Kingdom. We agree with the Father and His good gifts—crowns of life and scrolls of destiny are being released from heaven. They are yours to receive, beloved. The Lord is your Redeemer. He loves you, and we love you. Nothing can hold back His love.

Jesus, cause them to lock eyes with You to see the flame of love that is blazing in Your eyes. Transform cold love into passionate love toward You. May the light of Your countenance shine on them and give them peace. Remove every counterfeit love and replace it with real Love—Your very Presence. Help them to abide in You and never look back. In Jesus' name, release the redeeming power of Your Love.



DAY 24 – BEHOLD JEHOVAH-NISSI

As the Holy Spirit is tearing down and removing counterfeit love, in its place He is establishing *Himself* over them like a banner. This is a massive exchange in orientation as covenants are shifting. The vows and idol worship under the LGBTQ+ rainbow banner are coming down from their high places and being replaced with the covenant name of God—*Jehovah-Nissi*, the Lord is My Banner. God Himself is covering them, and the banner over them is Love (Song of Solomon 2:4).

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Exodus 17:8-16

PRAYER:

We lift high the covenant name of our Father God—Jehovah-Nissi, the Lord is My Banner. We proclaim Your great name, like a banner of protection, over those being saved. Wave Your battle flag over them, God! Surround them with Your great love and protect them as they walk out their salvation and deliverance. As intercessors, we lift high our hands in worship as the Lord wars on your behalf. We will see this victory through!

Jehovah-Nissi, You have promised to be at war with the predatory spirit of Amalek that prowls around looking for someone to devour (Exodus 17:17; 1 Peter 5:8). We thank you that this battle belongs to You. You have declared it to be Yours from generation to generation. Kingdom of God, come! Scatter and destroy the enemy that preys on weaknesses and seeks to take advantage during this transition. Protect and cover every single rescued one with the banner of Your great name.

We lift Your name up, God! Thank you that You are declaring Yourself over them like a banner lifted high. Your Name is above all names. All power and authority are Yours. May Your strong Love over them be seen like a banner flying high in the sky. We declare that they are Yours!



DAY 25 – PETITIONING GOD TO OVERTHROW THE WORKS OF SATAN

“The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil” (1 John 3:8).

Whether we recognize it or not, we are all affected by the widespread reach of the LGBTQ+ movement. We need God’s purification in our homes and within the Church. We are asking for nations to be saved and delivered into purity and righteousness. With our confession and repentance of sin, coupled with the Blood of the Lamb, we are asking God to overthrow the works of Satan so that He would have a generation who seeks Him in holiness and purity. Our asking includes a mighty shift from the onslaught of sexual confusion and perverted justice to a holy clarity of the Lord’s moral rightness and justness. May we all be washed in the Word of God, sanctified in truth, and justified in Christ Jesus.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: 2 Corinthians 4:3-6; Ephesians 6:10-18

PRAYER:

Father, as we bring before You this LGBTQ+ movement that has labeled itself PRIDE, help us to remain in humility. Let us see clearly the importance, protection, and freedom of being within the boundary lines of humility. Convict us quickly when we overstep our bounds into pride. You oppose the proud but give grace to the humble (James 4:6). Would You give us this grace as we intercede with You? We greatly desire deliverance, forgiveness, and healing to abound in our land (2 Chronicles 7:14).

God, we want to be made clean and holy. Rend our hearts with identificational repentance. We open up to You and own the sin inside of us: personally, generationally, in the Church, and in my nation. We have grievously sinned against You, God.

Wherever LGBTQ+ mindsets, activity, and agendas have manifested in our nation, and wherever we, personally and within our generational lines, have manifested it or have given ourselves over to serving the demonic forces behind it, we agree quickly with our adversary and confess that as sin (Matthew 5:25; 1 Corinthians 11:28-31). We repent for our sin of rebellion and our sin of disobedience. We repent for how we have engaged sexual sin and immorality. We sincerely repent and want no part of it any longer. Have mercy, Lord. Cleanse us with the Blood of Jesus. May our hearts be sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water (Hebrews 10:22). Please forgive us for defiling the image of God. Holy Spirit, come and sanctify; repair and restore. Please heal us, reconcile us to God, and heal our land.



DAY 26 – PULLING DOWN STRONGHOLDS

Spiritual weapons in the Kingdom of God have divine power to pull down strongholds. Let us battle in prayer to take down PRIDE's lofty opinions exalted against our Holy God. In humility, we ask for the destruction of every deceptive argument set up against the knowledge of God. Let us bring into submission and lay before Him every disobedient thought and desire. As we do, may this cause every form of pride to be dethroned, with the removal and destruction of pride's false authority.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: 2 Corinthians 10:3-6; Romans 12:1-2

PRAYER:

Almighty God, lead us in the pulling down of strongholds. Teach us how to capture every thought to make it obedient to Christ. We submit our minds and mindsets to be renewed by the Word of God. We ask this for ourselves and for those we are lifting up in prayer. God, we acknowledge that our carnal mind wants control and resists the Holy Spirit, which hinders us from coming into and benefitting from Your abiding Presence (Romans 8:11). We ask for every hindrance to the work of Your Spirit be removed, in Jesus' name. We choose to exchange our carnal mind for the mind of Christ. We ask for this full exchange for those who struggle or identify as LGBTQ+.

Holy Spirit, illuminate the gospel and shine forth Your truth. Cause all darkness to flee. Break the power and influence of the LGBTQ+ agenda and its PRIDE movement on every sphere of society. Reverse deception's ploy to call evil good and good evil. Father of glory, as demonic strongholds of deception come down, would You pour out Your Spirit of wisdom and revelation in the full knowledge of God to take its place. Spirit of the LORD, come!

God, we ask for Your gift of healing to touch people's thought lives. Remove the degrading effects of lust; and in its place, allow Your goodness, purity, and righteousness to flood the mind. As pride is humbled, restore humanity to its original design, made in the image of God and made to be in intimate relationship with You. Would You impart holy discernment to know Your nature, Your heart, and Your will. Release Your Spirit of understanding with restorative peace.



DAY 27 – THE CHURCH PURIFIED

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: 1 Kings 18:17-40; Exodus 34:12-15; Matthew 4:10

The idols in our modern-day culture are much like those in the days of Elijah. Elijah's greatest work as a prophet of God was purifying Israel of Baal worship and turning the hearts of the people back to God. During Elijah's time, Ahab was an evil king over Israel, and he gave much of his kingly authority to his wife, Jezebel, who enforced Baal worship as the state's religion. Worship to Baal and Ashtoreth—the male and female gods of fertility—promoted worship to one's own procreative faculties designed to arouse and fulfill sexual desire. Worship to these false gods involved sexual orgies and lewd sexual practices that included prostitution, homosexuality, entertainment of being another gender, cross-dressing, live pornography, self-mutilation, and mass numbers of child sacrifices.

Worship to Baal and Ashtoreth is mentioned in 22 of the 66 books of the Bible. The first mention of this idol worship in Scripture indicates the Asherah pole to be a special object of God's hatred. The same passage is also where the Lord revealed His name as *Jealous*. It is also important to recognize that Baal worship led to the destruction of all Canaanite nations and, with other things, caused Israel to be banished among the other nations.

In our sex-saturated society, we don't have to look far to see the realities of modern-day Baal and Ashtoreth worship. A primary example of this is the sexually permissive, pro-LGBTQ+ belief system that now permeates every sphere of society. Likened to Jezebel's mandate, LGBTQ+ ideology has become like a *de facto* national religion, demanding our indoctrination and obedience.

The Church has not been excluded—nearly every major denomination has split over issues of morality relating to inclusion of LGBTQ+ beliefs and practice. The Church does not realize that where she has accepted (and in some cases even promoted) LGBTQ+ ideology, it has opened the door for the worship and service of Baal within the Church. Let us step into identificational repentance to appropriate the Blood of the Lamb for the purification of the Bride.

PRAYER:

We come before You fasting and praying for Your mercy. Father God, you urge us to rend our hearts: to truly see, feel, and know our true condition, to break agreement with sin and idolatry, and to renounce all allegiance to it. We come before Your throne of grace and mercy to repent personally and to stand in the gap and repent on behalf of the Church. Search us, O God.

We confess that there have been idols in our lives. We confess that this sin has caused a wavering in our hearts and in the Church. May we be rid of all idolatry and purified by Your Blood, Lord Jesus. Come, Holy Spirit, and rip the deception off our hearts and our minds. We have greatly sinned against You.

God, we repent for worshiping the created instead of our Creator. We repent for our many sexual sins and sexual permissiveness. We repent for being consumed with lust's passion to compromise, and we specifically repent for the sin of homosexuality and transgenderism embraced and blessed by the Church. God, we repent for the ways we have actively and passively prepared the way for this darkened understanding in the Church. God, would You highlight with clarity every false teaching and demonic doctrine within the Church, including queer theology. As members of Your Body, we renounce them!

Lord, have mercy and purify us unto holiness. We ask for a great shift and a massive turning to love You wholeheartedly and serve You alone. Create in us a clean heart and renew a right spirit in many people's lives, in the Church, and in our nation.



DAY 28 – THE SPIRIT AND POWER OF ELIJAH

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Malachi 4: 5-6; Luke 1:16-17; Revelation 2:18-29

In the spirit and power of Elijah, we must expose Jezebel's activity in the Church and heed the Lord's call to repent. God has foreseen the true status of the end-time Church and has given us His instructive insight (Revelation 2:1-3:22). Therefore, we must receive His rebuke and no longer tolerate sexual immorality or the rewriting of biblical morality. Otherwise, we will face grave consequences, because never (past, present, or future) is our worship to God to be mixed and defiled with the world's idolatry.

The Church has been a target of Jezebel's seduction. Her idol worship that is filled with sexual immorality has been practiced by some and tolerated by many in the Church. We must come out from under her witchcraft to become Christ's pure and spotless Bride, His victorious Church—thriving in Christ's moral authority and power. We must come back to first-commandment love.

Let us take courage in knowing that biblical prophecy provides the Lord's remedy to Jezebel's proliferation of Baal worship in the last days. As seen both in the Old Testament when Jezebel was first confronted and in what is prophesied to come in the last days, moving in the spirit and power of Elijah is what tears down the altars of Baal and Ashtoreth and ushers in the restoration of true worship in wholehearted devotion to God.

PRAYER:

God, we are grieved where we, the Church who is Your Bride, have tolerated Jezebel and have not maintained a clear adherence to biblical morality and obedience. Jesus, help us! Would You release the spirit of Elijah to wake us up—to wake up the Church, and to wake up our nation to a radical obedience—to love God with all our hearts and worship Him with no mixture of worship to false gods?

We join together in one voice under the Blood of the Lamb, saying: We renounce you, Baal. We renounce you, Ashtoreth. We renounce you, Jezebel. We renounce their idol worship from our lives, our family lines, and from the Church, in the name of Jesus. We renounce our compromises to every unclean thing. We speak to every altar and stronghold of Baal and Ashtoreth in our hearts, in our communities, in our churches: Fall, right now from your high place. We break covenant with every secret sin. We break agreement with all carousal of sin. We declare that we will not bow the knee to Jezebel, and we will no longer partake of her idol worship through sexual immorality.

Sovereign God, we extol You to Your proper place. You are the Most High. You are higher. There is none like You. You are full of glory, majesty, and splendor. Let it be known that You are Jehovah, the True and Living God. Would You release Your power? Would You release signs and wonders establishing Your Lordship in our family lines, the Church, and in the nations? May all see, once again, demonstrations that You alone are God! "Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you blameless before the Presence of His glory with great joy, to the only God, our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen" (Jude 1:24-25).



DAY 29 – HOLY BOLDNESS

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: 1 Kings 18:21; Acts 4:29-30

PRAYER:

Lord, we are asking for a Spirit of boldness to descend upon us, bringing freedom to declare the Good News fearlessly. We are asking to be filled with a Spirit of dedication and consecration to Jesus. Strengthen us to not shrink back, but to wholeheartedly serve You as we live out the gospel. Come and fill us, Holy Spirit.

Spirit of Truth, would You rebuke all confusion and ambivalence? Cast these evil effects off Your Church. We agree with You and say: Be gone, in Jesus' name. We reject every dark statement and lofty thought being spoken and believed by our culture that exalts itself against the knowledge of God. Where we have been cowardly silent, cause us to stand with You, Jesus. We take this stand in love toward You. We truly repent and receive the mind of Christ. We bind our heart to Yours. Cause us to be one with You. We break our agreement with the prayerlessness in our lives that has turned into silence. As we abide in You, with the mind of Christ and the Father's heart, we will not be silent.

Let us not be a people who say nothing. Remove the demonic deception and fear that has closed our mouths and muted us into agreement with them. Our tolerance of Jezebel and her false authority has caused our lips to be sealed and our hearts to be unresponsive to the Holy Spirit's conviction. The Jezebel spirit has propagandized sexual immorality with wide-scale acceptance and has manipulated many into thinking that evil ways are good and honorable. Power of God, come and break every witchcraft spell that has been cast upon the minds and hearts of the people!

Lord, we renounce the fear of man in our hearts. We repent for how the fear of man has bound us in silence. We ask for our delight and sense of safety to no longer be governed by the fear of man, but to be found in the fear of the Lord. We renounce the fear of losing popularity for the Truth (Jesus). We have been more concerned about what people think of us than about having our pleasure and love rooted and grounded in You. God, unite our hearts in love to fear Your name, which is above every other name. As we consecrate ourselves to You, let us declare the Good News in clarity and love, with all boldness. Cause us to stand in the gap, holding the line for truth and the love of God.



DAY 30 – RESTORING THE BOUNDARY LINES

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: 2 Timothy 4:3-4; Isaiah 5:20; Job 24:2; Hosea 5:10 (AMP)

Many people have left churches that preach sound doctrine and healthy teaching to search for a church who accepts and affirms LGBTQ+ lifestyle choices. Many congregations have moved God's boundary lines between good and evil. The world's morality is now being preached in some pulpits. Evil is being relabeled as good and many are accepting the redefinition. What is good, righteous, and holy is being labeled as hate and evil. Preaching repentance and forgiveness is labeled as hurtful and offensive. Let us stand in the gap and cry out for mercy.

PRAYER:

Lord, we confess that we have sinned against You by moving Your boundary markers regarding right and wrong! We have not consistently preached or adhered to the message of the Cross of Christ or the transformational and creative reality of baptism. We have neglected the power of faith that causes us to: receive Your grace, crucify our flesh, and become God's new creation full of life through the empowering and indwelling Holy Spirit. In these ways we have denied who You really are and the great love You have for us to be free from sin and death. God, please forgive us.

Lord, have mercy and save those who have wandered off into myths and lies! Whether it is blatant demonic doctrine that has infiltrated our minds and hearts, or believing the lie that the Truth that sets us free is "unloving and offensive," we repent for aligning with the devil by calling evil good and good evil. Reveal within us every place of passivity and fear of man that has actually caused us to align with an anti-Christ spirit.

By Your great love, teach and train us in true discipleship to Jesus Christ. Cause a great turning to happen in the Church and reveal Your ways by encountering us with Your Holy Spirit and the fear of the Lord. Let the effects of encountering You cause the Church to rise up, repent, and take back the ground that has been given over to false gods and false teaching. Redeem Your Church and purify Your Bride so that we might be truly one with You in all Your ways, revealing Your glory.

Would You release Your fire that proceeds from Your Throne to consume all Your adversaries (Psalm 97:3; Isaiah 26:11)? Burn up every false teaching, God. Every prophet and priest of Baal, be removed from the Church in Jesus' name. Lord, put holy and righteous leaders, who are shepherds after Your own heart, in their places. Protect Your flock to be blameless and faithful at Your coming. Mark Your Church with the power of holiness and the fear of the Lord to make straight paths for You. Light up Your Way; light up Your Truth—reveal Your Son. Restore integrity. Restore morality. Cause us to fulfill our calling to be holy like You.



DAY 31 – HOPE IN THE WAITING

The needs of broken humanity are screaming all around us. We see it in the nations, in our cities, and in our churches. We can feel it in our own hearts, and hear it in the hearts of those to whom we minister. Brokenness is beyond our control. No matter where the need lies, it is only in and through Jesus Christ that these needs will be met.

As intercessors, we are called to the “in-between”—to be in the great divide between need’s lack and fulfillment’s relief—because intercession always precedes action. The place “in-between” is in the land of hope leading to the fulfillment of our prayers rooted in God’s promises. In intercession, we not only usher in the requests for mercy and change but we usher in the *hosanna*—“the expression of joy and praise for deliverance granted or anticipated.” This prophetically prepares the way for the Lord to answer. We are called to stand firm in the “not yet”—watching, praying, and believing with hope’s assurance that Jesus is the answer to every need and that He is faithful to meet them as we ask for His help. We are called to be persistent in prayer and abiding in hope.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Luke 11:1-13; Isaiah 64:4; Psalm 40:1

We are calling upon the Lord for a great release of hope as we continue to cry out for salvation, healing, and deliverance for those in the LGBTQ+ who have yet to encounter the Father’s love. As we express the needs to Jesus and wait for His answer, we proclaim that He is the only hope. He is the hope for the Church to rightly respond to the sexually broken. He is the hope for deliverance of those who are oppressed.

PRAYER:

God, thank you for Your meekness and for how You incline Yourself toward us. You are the God who draws near and comes close to hear our prayers. God, we thank you that the activity of waiting patiently on You, includes persistent prayer. In the waiting, we declare that we are confident of Your faithfulness. We are confident of Your responsiveness to every care we present to You, and we trust Your timing to answer.

You are the God who listens. We cry out to You in desperation with needs that only Your provision can meet. May our heart's cry come before You in a posture of humility, thankfulness, faith, and expectation. Salvation and deliverance come from You and You alone.

You are also the God who acts. Thank you for how You respond to our prayers. In advance, we thank you for Your delivering power. We thank you for how You deliver us up and out of every pit of destruction. Thank you that You transfer us out of sin's swampy decay of brokenness and place us upon You, our Rock and solid ground. From You alone, do we find stability, assurance, and security. As You have done it with us, God, we are asking You to do it for the LGBTQ+. May they encounter Your love and receive Your saving grace.

Jesus, You are our hope. You are our answer. You are our rescue. You are our victory. In Jesus' name, we declare Your promise that You act on behalf of those who wait patiently and confidently in You!



DAY 32 – LOVE’S POWER

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: 1 Corinthians 13:1-13

PRAYER:

Thank you, Jesus! We continue to fill the narrow way with the power of faith that moves every mountain standing in the way of Jesus being revealed in the LGBTQ+ community. Lord, as we release this faith, permeate us with Your love so that we will love as You love. You instructed us to ask for the good way so that we may walk in it (Jeremiah 6:16). We ask for the good and most excellent way of love to be this path.

In love, by love, and through love, we clear the way. As children of God, we release faith that makes a way where there is no way. We step into the fullness of faith and the fullness of love that enlightens the path and paves the way to true freedom and everlasting life. Jesus, You are the way; You are love (John:14:6; 1 John 4:8). Lead them to the path that leads to You and draw them into Your perfect love. As they step onto Your path, the most excellent way of love, cause their hearts to come alive.

We seize the vision and the God-designed destiny for the rainbow people to behold the Lamb who takes away the sin of the world. We seize it with such a grip that it cannot be taken away until it is fulfilled! To all who are under the rainbow banner, let them have encounters with Jesus! We proclaim in the name of Jesus the power of God’s love to the LGBTQ+ community. May God, who is love, triumph over every lie and distortion of love. Let truth, faith, hope, and love unite with power to save.

God, Your love never ceases, never passes away, always perseveres, and is steadfast to the end. Your love never fails. We declare: The excellent way of Love (Jesus) resurrects life and leads to face-to-face communion with Love Himself. Lord, let Your perfect love come to the LGBTQ+ community, causing all imperfect love to disappear.



DAY 33 – GOD’S SIGN: THE RAINBOW

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Genesis 9:12-15; Ezekiel 1:26-28; Revelation 4:2-3

In Scripture, the rainbow holds incredible prophetic significance. Its first mention is in Genesis chapter 9, when God established the rainbow as a sign of His covenant with Noah after the Flood. Smith’s Bible Dictionary beautifully sums up the rainbow’s real meaning. It is:

The token of the covenant which God made with Noah when he came forth from the ark that the waters should no more become a flood to destroy all flesh. The right interpretation of Genesis 9:13 seems to be that God took the rainbow, which had hitherto been but a beautiful object shining in the heavens when the sun’s rays fell on falling rain, and **consecrated it as the sign of His love and the witness of His promise.** The rainbow is a **symbol of God’s faithfulness and mercy.** In the “rainbow around the throne,” (Revelation 4:3) it is seen the **symbol of hope and the bright emblem of mercy and love,** all the more true as a symbol because it is reflected from the storm itself.¹

In the days of Noah, giants existed to contest the promises of God. The enemy’s tactics have not changed. Today, a spiritual giant is at work through the LGBTQ+ agenda and its movement called PRIDE. This LGBTQ+ giant is releasing a powerful demonic assignment that is violent toward God, the image of God, His commands, and His covenantal promises. Satan has mocked God by using the rainbow—God’s consecrated sign of His promise and divine faithfulness—to parade its abomination (Leviticus 18:22; 20:13; 1 Corinthians 6:9-11; Romans 1:26-28, 32).

In both Ezekiel and Revelation, we see that in the unveiled glory of God’s Presence and around His throne, the rainbow’s beauty and its promise are forever on display. Knowing this reality, let us prophesy that the rainbow banner over LGBTQ+ people is actually a declaration for the glory of God to be revealed through them!

PRAYER:

Everlasting Father, You are a covenant-keeping God. You are the Faithful One. We thank you for Your holy consecration of the rainbow as a forever sign of Your great love, Your faithfulness, and Your mercy. Jesus, You are the promise; You are the hope and bright emblem of mercy and love.

Therefore, we prophetically declare the rainbow banner to be a callsign for God to bring encounters with Jesus, who is the radiant rainbow of light! We ask for each wave of the LGBTQ+ rainbow flag, be a prophetic act to call forth God’s wave as prophesied by Bob Jones that saves, purifies, redeems, and restores. May the rainbow be a prophetic summons to baptism—the passage out of the curse of sin and death and in to the resurrected life of Christ.

We continue to prophesy for those who have paraded in PRIDE with an allegiance to the rainbow flag: may they encounter the glory of God, through the Presence of God, producing a holy fear of God. Behold the Lamb, who is high and lifted up and seated on the throne!

DAY 34 – HOLY SPIRIT POURED OUT

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: John 11:25-26; Joel 2:28-29, 32; Luke 11:13

As we saw yesterday, we have turned the rainbow flag into a prophetic declaration for the covenantal promises of God to be fulfilled in and for the rainbow people. God has a promise that “in the last days it shall be that I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh...and it shall come to pass that everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved” (Acts 2:17, 21).

God’s desire is for none to perish. This is radical mercy: the Holy One coming upon unholy flesh. No human being can remain the same after encountering the Living God. This is the power of grace and His means for liberty, for “*where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom*” (2 Corinthians 3:17). This redemption is resurrection life, and this salvation begins with liberation from evil. When the Holy Spirit is poured out, the eyes of men and women see spiritual realities more clearly than ever before, and their ears hear ever so loudly the voice of the Lord.

PRAYER:

Hallelujah! Let us continue to prophecy for the rainbow people to receive the poured out Holy Spirit with invitations of salvation unto resurrection life in the here and now. Many will believe and choose a baptism into Christ, activating their resurrection from the dead. Saul-like conversions are coming and are now here! Those sitting in darkness shall see a great Light (Jesus), and for those dwelling in the shadow of death, a Light will shine upon them (Isaiah 9:2; Matthew 4:16). Widespread repentance will replace PRIDE parading through the streets. Captives will be set free from sexual immorality’s bondage to sin and death—all to display the glory of God and His glorious redemption.

God, we are asking for extravagant mercy with the pouring out of Your Spirit. Let Your Presence of love, resurrection, and life permeate this community. Jesus, come and have Your glory! Father, magnify Your Son, who is true life and true love, so that He may be seen and known by all who are in the LGBTQ+ community.



DAY 35 – GOSPEL OF LOVE

Let us declare to God that we believe Bob Jones' prophetic word that a wave of 100,000 LGBTQ+ people will be saved and redeemed into their true identity as they encounter the power and purity of the gospel of Jesus Christ. A mighty awakening to Jesus, who is Love, is coming.

Through His tender eyes of mercy, we all see our reflection. Nothing is hidden. As He searches our mind and heart, He opens up His nail-scarred hands and says: *Put it all here; give it all to Me*. There is no fear with this summoning, for behind His eyes is a pathway to peace—a narrow road too pressing to have us heavy-hearted and distracted by sin's burden. Jesus does not bring conviction's choice to shame us, but to rid us from every entanglement so that we can fully embrace His holy road toward life and authentic freedom.

Locked eyes with Jesus, we are all softened by His love, His compassion, and His mercy. We can see in the depth of His eyes and know He has loved us first. Love searches us out and we become beautifully undone. Nothing compares to the real love of God that we were made for—in union, communion, and rest. With sin's barrier removed, His eyes of love now say: *Come and follow Me. I have a journey for you to go on*.

Love has now been awakened, and we will never be the same. Everything changes because of His love. No more counterfeit loves. No more false liberations. No more lies, only truth. We now know through experience what it is like to be loved with the purest and most passionate love. The love of God surpasses anything we have ever tasted, felt, or seen. It is what we have longed for but have never attained in this world.

How do we respond to this kind of love? We bring all of our self to Him, because He has brought all of Himself to us. We abandon our self to Love (God), saying: *Take my life, Jesus. Make me; mold me; use me. All I am is Yours. All I now want is to love You rightly. Your beauty is breath-taking. Your love is heart-stopping. Nothing compares to Your Presence. All of myself still seems too little of an offering, but all I have is Yours. With all of me offered, nothing can separate or take me away from the love of God*.

We can now see the high value of exposing every lie, every temptation, every thought captive to the obedience to Christ—so that this relationship with Love will never be interrupted, but ever-growing and unceasing. Face to face with Love creates in us experiential understanding of love. The journey set before us is the most excellent way of all. It is increasing beyond measure in deeper depths and higher heights in the love of Christ.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION and PRAYER: John 14:21-27; 15:9-11; Song of Songs 2:10-14 (TPT)



DAY 36 – THE SOUND OF THE RESCUED ONES

A sound *is* coming. It is the sound of the rescued ones. Those who have been imprisoned by the powers of darkness and enslaved by the wrath of sexual immorality, who have now been set free and saved by Jesus, will release a sound of revival that cannot be denied.

These dear ones have known all too well the inner slavery of sexual sin and its fierce ever-increasing demands for fulfillment. As they have come face to face with Jesus, the fire in His eyes has not spared them from seeing the true condition of their heart. This is the Lord's kindness that through His eyes of love He allows us to see ourselves clearly. It is here we come face to face with Truth, who has the power to set free.

Having been found and rescued, to love Him back is the natural response, and gladly will they follow Him. The flame in His eyes has enlightened their eyes to truly see and warmed their heart to feel deeply. Jesus has become their bridge, and in trust, they walk away from a sin-filled land of slavery (never to live in again), toward a new promised land of His goodness, righteousness, and godly inheritance.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Romans 1:16-17; Revelation 12:10-11; 1 Peter 2:9-10

PRAYER:

We thank you for the testimonies of the LGBTQ+ rescued ones—the testimony of Jesus transforming their lives by the power of His Blood. Create through them the sound of the redeemed—sounds of hope and faith; healing and deliverance; salvation and redemption. Loose the testimonies of those who have been set free from the bonds of sexual confusion and have found true love in identifying with Christ. Loose the hope that Jesus has the power to transform sinful desires and shift the longings of the soul toward righteousness. Release a sound through their testimony by the Word of the Lord that breaks the heavy yoke of sin, declares the truth that sets free, and releases light that shines in the darkness making visible every hidden prison of the soul.

We come into agreement with the Word of God and declare that because of the death and resurrection of Jesus the enemy has been defeated. In the Spirit, we proclaim to those who have believed and received salvation that You are more than conquerors in Christ who has loved you. We proclaim life's blessing over the rescued ones: You are significant in the eyes of the Lord. You were made with greatness. You are not small. Do not let the enemy keep you quiet. Your testimony is a weapon. You have a voice; you have a song. Use your voice to bless the Lord with all that is within you. Bless Him with all your soul, with all of your body, and with the fullness of your spirit now alive and kept blameless by the Lord. Let it out! Release your hallelujah, the Lord reigns! The Lord loves it, and the world needs to hear it! You have a redemption sound that creation longs to hear. Open your mouth and the Lord will fill it. Now is the time. Do not delay—the time is short. Lift up your voice. Deliverance has come and your breakthrough will never end.



DAY 37 – THE SONG OF THE REDEEMED

Pray, prophesy, and give thanks using Psalm 107 as your guide.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Psalm 107

PRAYER:

We honor You, God! Thank you for Your goodness! You are good and Your mercy endures forever! We thank you for Your wonderful works of redemption for the rainbow people! You have brought them up and out and into Your heart. Thank you for Your lovingkindness. We declare Your works with rejoicing.

Lord, thank you for Your steadfast love. You answer the cries of the afflicted. You save from the worst of conditions. You satisfy every longing. You fill the hungry with good things. With one word, You cut away the cords of oppression and move us out of darkness and into light. You raise the dead to life. There is no one like You. Let the redeemed of the Lord say so!

As the redeemed proclaim their worship and thanksgiving to God, may their lives be marked with the anointing of the Lord. God, would You baptize them in Your Holy Spirit? In union with You, commission them to proclaim and demonstrate the gospel of Jesus Christ. Send them out into their own communities with the Holy Spirit's power to heal the wounds of the brokenhearted, to comfort the afflicted, and to bring deliverance to the spiritual captives. As they do, may Christ be seen and known through them. May they honor You, God, with tremendous distinction, and may their reward in heaven be great.



DAY 38 – EKBALLO

In this fast, we have rent our hearts with identificational intercession and repentance—preparing the way of the Lord. We have been plowing in the unseen for a great harvest of souls, and our prayers have been sown in tears. Take comfort in God’s promise: *“To those who sow in tears shall reap in joy. He who continually goes forth weeping, bearing seed for sowing, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him”* (Psalm 126:5-6).

The prophetic word that we have been holding before the Lord not only prophesies for 100,000 salvations out of the LGBTQ+ community but that these souls saved would be just the *first* wave of many to follow. For decades the prophetic intercession regarding this word has called for Saul-like conversions so powerful that these 100,000 would become powerful evangelists and preachers of righteousness in their own communities—causing a multiplication of souls coming into the Kingdom of God. Their love for Jesus will be unstoppable and the Holy Spirit will confirm their acceptance, belonging, and commissioning in the Kingdom as they freely move in the gifts of the Spirit.

Joy is coming. Fulfillment is coming. Let us heed the words spoken by Jesus, *“The harvest is truly great, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest”* (Luke 10:2). The Greek word for pray is *deomai*, which means to want, need, or see need, then make known that need—to supplicate until that need is fully met. The Greek word for send is *ekballo*, which means to eject, cast out, expel or send away. Our prayers have divine power to initiate action to thrust out reapers.

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Psalm 126; Luke 10:1-2

PRAYER:

In the Spirit, we blow the trumpet and cry out: Ekballo! Send out the laborers! Lord of the harvest, drive the laborers into Your field. Send forth the 100,000 to labor in the Kingdom. Release them into the rainbow harvest to do Your work: gathering souls into the Kingdom, casting out demons, moving in resurrection power (Matthew 10:7-8). May they teach and preach the gospel with love, wisdom, and power. May they move freely in the gifts of the Spirit.

As the redeemed walk in the newness of life in Jesus, would You send them out in the spirit and power of Elijah—turning the hearts of many toward God, making ready for the LORD a people prepared (Luke 1:17). Mark them with a unique ministry that is able to reach those in the LGBTQ+ community that others cannot reach. Let them find buried treasures in the field. And as they do, may they wreak havoc on the enemy by becoming Your ministers of deliverance and healing. Multiply Your reward through them—thirty, sixty, even one hundredfold.

We declare that the Lord will have the reward of His suffering in His redemption of the rainbow people! This harvest field will not be overlooked! Where there has been delay, we say: No more delay!

In Jesus’ name, Lord of the harvest, ekballo laborers into Your field with authority and power!



DAY 39 – WAVES OF REVIVAL

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Ezekiel 43:2; Isaiah 59:19-21 (TPT); John 7:37-39; Song of Songs 8:6-7

PRAYER:

Almighty God, release the sound of the rescued ones and the song of the redeemed like the sound of many waters. As the multitude of voices band together, let their sound become one (Ephesians 4:4-6). Let their voice be Your voice. Let their testimony of Jesus be the rising of Your living water bursting forth through them.

This is the wave of revival we are crying out for—the sound of many waters, with all of Your waves and breakers crashing over us. Let Your voice come crashing down, like a mighty tidal wave, that comes with the intensity of Your love, Your glory, and Your redemption. God, would You cause these waves of the Spirit to release the cleansing, refreshing, and joy of the Lord, so that many would receive You with clarity and conviction and with the fullness of Your Spirit?

Holy Spirit flow, wave after wave, with the anointing of Jesus (Luke 4:17-21). Pour out Your anointing upon Your faithful witnesses as they bring the Good News. Send them out with healing for the brokenhearted and liberty to those who are bound. Anoint the preaching of Your Word with salvation, healing, and deliverance. May Your favor rest upon them, giving You glory.

As they overflow, set their hearts on fire with the very flame of the Lord. Baptize them in Your fire, Lord. With burning hearts, release the love of Christ and the works of Christ through them. Make their very lives a sign and wonder of Your Lordship and love to the LGBTQ+ community, the Church, and the world. May the sign and wonder of their lives instigate a massive turning to the Lord with a revelation of the Great I AM (Exodus 3:14). All for Your glory. All for Love's sake. So be it, Lord, according to Your Word.

In Jesus' name, release the sound of the rescued ones like the sound of many waters that is sent out, making the Lord's waves of revival.



DAY 40 – BEHOLD THE RISEN LAMB

Many believe the work and ministry of John the Baptist is a prototype for what the sons and daughters of God will be in the last generation. Filled with the Holy Spirit, this generation will release the call to repentance, baptizing many into Christ. Having been prepared in the secret places of the wilderness, they will cry out with urgency and clarity, *“Behold the Lamb of God!”* Just as John the Baptist prepared the way for the Messiah’s first coming, so will the last generation move in the spirit and power of Elijah to prepare the people for Jesus’ second coming. Jesus declared John to be the greatest man to ever live, so will this generation be the greatest.

Let us end our fast by not only proclaiming the cry of John the Baptist to behold the Lamb, but also heaven’s! When the Apostle John received the unveiling of Jesus Christ as recorded in the book of Revelation, he too was told to behold Him! And what John saw was a Lamb who “appeared to have been slaughtered but was now alive!” (Revelation 5:6, TPT).

Worthy is the Lamb who is, who was, and who is to come. He alone is found worthy! Come, Lord Jesus!

SCRIPTURE MEDITATION: Revelation 5:6-14

PRAYER:

“Because You were slaughtered for us, you are worthy to take the scroll and open its seals. Your blood was the price paid to redeem us. You purchased us to bring us to God out of every tribe, language, people group, and nation. You have chosen us to serve our God and formed us into a kingdom of priests who reign on the earth.” (Revelation 5:9-10, TPT)

“Worthy is Christ the Lamb who was slaughtered to receive great power and might, wealth and wisdom, and honor, glory, and praise!” (Revelation 5:12, TPT)

“Praise, honor, glory, and dominion be to God-Enthroned and to Christ the Lamb forever and ever!” (Revelation 5:13, TPT)
